

# A Caring and Inclusive Home for All

The theme for this year, "A Caring and Inclusive Home for All", is aligned with the President's Challenge's focus on giving everyone a chance to contribute to society, and inspired our pre-schoolers to care for their community in their own unique ways.

This year's movement has taken on greater significance as the preschool sector comes together to uplift spirits and do good for others amidst the ongoing COVID-19 situation.















Over 53,000 children embarked on SSDB projects this year. The movement has grown six-fold, from 150 preschools in 2015, to 950 preschools this year, the highest participation by preschools to-date.

Parents showed support for their children by participating in their project activities, either at home or online. Teachers and parents also made use of the new 'Start Small Dream Big' Activity Kit, developed by Preschool Market and ECDA, to engage their children meaningfully.





The children brought in cardboards to experience rough sleeping and its discomforts.. The children brainstormed ways to help these rough sleepers and decided to write notes of encouragement to them. 

The project on caring for people with visual impairment was initiated when the children were learning about their eyes and daily eyecare habits. The centre then engaged Ms Amanda, a Vision Teacher from iC2 Prephouse, to learn more about visual impairment. The children learnt about the experiences of visually impaired persons. Through a Zoom interview, they discovered how a Perkins Brailler is used to print Braille on paper, and how a white cane is different from a walking stick. The children learned how to read and write in Braille, how to create art using textured paint, how to use visual aids in public, and how to offer help to someone who is visually impaired.

#### Water for you, me and the world!

#### Carpe Diem Childcare Resort

The children embarked on a project to understand the importance of water and its role in the environment. They also learned about water pollution and its effect on marine life. Through various experiments, activities and stories, they learned that they can help the environment by saving water and keeping the ocean clean. They also learned about water saving tips and made a pledge to conserve water in different ways. They made posters to raise awareness on keeping our oceans clean, and created a 'Water Wonder of the World' theme park using their own imagination and creativity!

#### **Nature and Me!**

The little gardeners attended online Zoom workshops with NParks officers who engaged them in small activities such as observing sprouts and seed germination. They also learned about park etiquette. The children became immersed in the process of gardening, through storytelling sessions, activity sheets provided by NParks, and growing their own green beans, kangkong, and sunflower plants in the community garden. #### Today's Innovators, Tomorrow's Future



#### Little Atlas Preschool

For their project, the preschool wanted to investigate how they can adopt a sustainable approach into their everyday teaching practice. They started out with a home-based learning kit which included recyclables for the children and their families to transform into interesting toys. The teachers then set up a play area consisting of only recycled materials and existing resources, which the children enjoyed. It even made the children less interested in playing with conventional toys, and more eager to build their own creative toys and games with the materials available. To further advocate to others on the importance of recycling and zero waste, the children created posters with recycled materials.

















#### **Gearing Towards** Zero Waste

MOE Kindergarten @ Kranji

The K1 children brainstormed the different types of waste produced by humans, and started to wonder about where the waste end up. Through Captain Green's videos, the children discovered about the Semakau Landfill. They explored ways to reduce waste through dramatization and role-play, and came up with simple solutions such as bringing their own reusable bags to the supermarket or their own container for takeaways at the hawker centre. They decided to reduce plastic waste by designing their own reusable bags and participating in a 5-days Zero Waste Challenge with their parents.











#### In Touch with Nature

#### MY World @ Punggol Edge

The children learned about four endangered animals that are close to extinction - pangolins, giant otters, orang utans and gibbons. The children formulated questions about these animals, which were answered through investigations and resources from the Singapore Zoo. They explored sustainable homes for animals in the rainforest by creating their own mini in-school rainforest.

It was heart-warming to see students take charge of their own learning processes, building an invaluable affinity for the animals and the world-at-large in the process. Children learned that plastic pollution is one of the top contributing factors in our environmental problems. They were introduced to the ECObrick - plastic bottles packed with used plastic which can then be used to build various items such as furniture, garden walls and other structures. With their parents help, the children made 75 ECObricks in one and a half month. They then worked on making durable seats using the ECObricks which they could use in their reading and learning corners! They pledged to continue their habit of recycling and turning plastic wastes to ECObricks, to help fight climate change.



Started in 2000, the President's Challenge is an annual community outreach and fund-raising campaign for beneficiaries selected yearly by the President's Office.
